#### Background

Are you a college graduate? SEO Scholars relies on volunteer mentors to drive its free, eight-year, academic program that gets low-income public high school students to and through college – with a 90% college graduation rate. 100% of SEO Scholars are accepted to four-year colleges, with more than 80% being first-generation college graduates.

#### Support from Osaic Foundation

The Osaic Foundation has committed a \$75,000 grant this year to SEO to reinforce and expand its outreach to students. This creates a new opportunity for advisors, their staff and home office employees located near the cities listed above to volunteer as mentors each week during the coming 2024-2025 school year.

#### What is the role of an SEO Scholars Mentor?

- ✓ Have a bachelor's degree
- ✓ Have 2+ years of professional experience
- ✓ Pass a background check (paid for by SEO)
- ✓ Maintain consistent and reliable communication with scholar/mentee
- ✓ Cultivate a trusting professional relationship
- ✓ Supportive of the scholar's academic and professional growth
- ✓ Model professionalism and maintain SEO Scholars mission and value of academics and growth

#### What is the commitment?

Based on the city, commit to 7-12 in person meetings, for one full year, starting in September and ending in May. Each meeting will be 2-3 hours, 1-2 times per month.

Applicants will be interviewed over this summer and notified if accepted.
