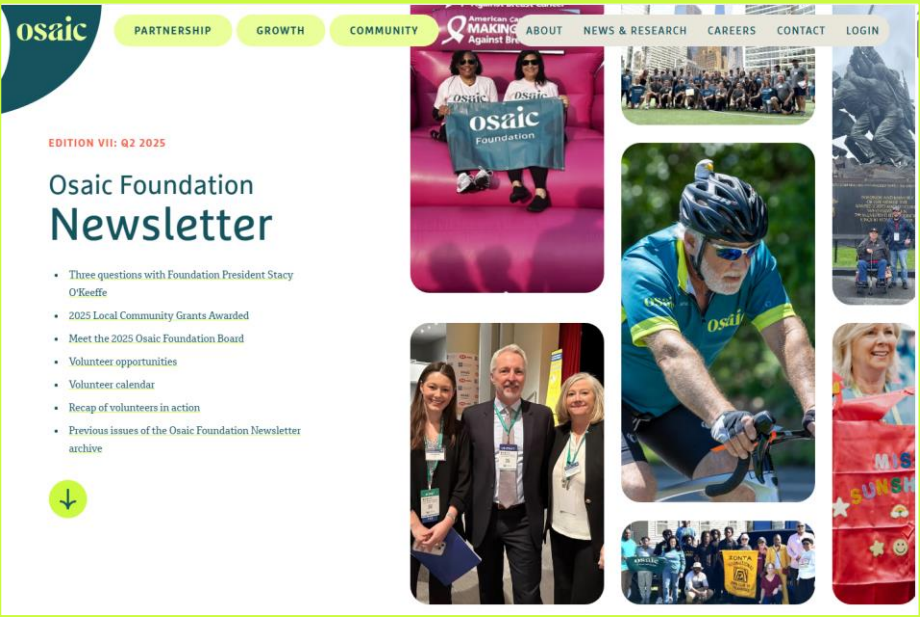

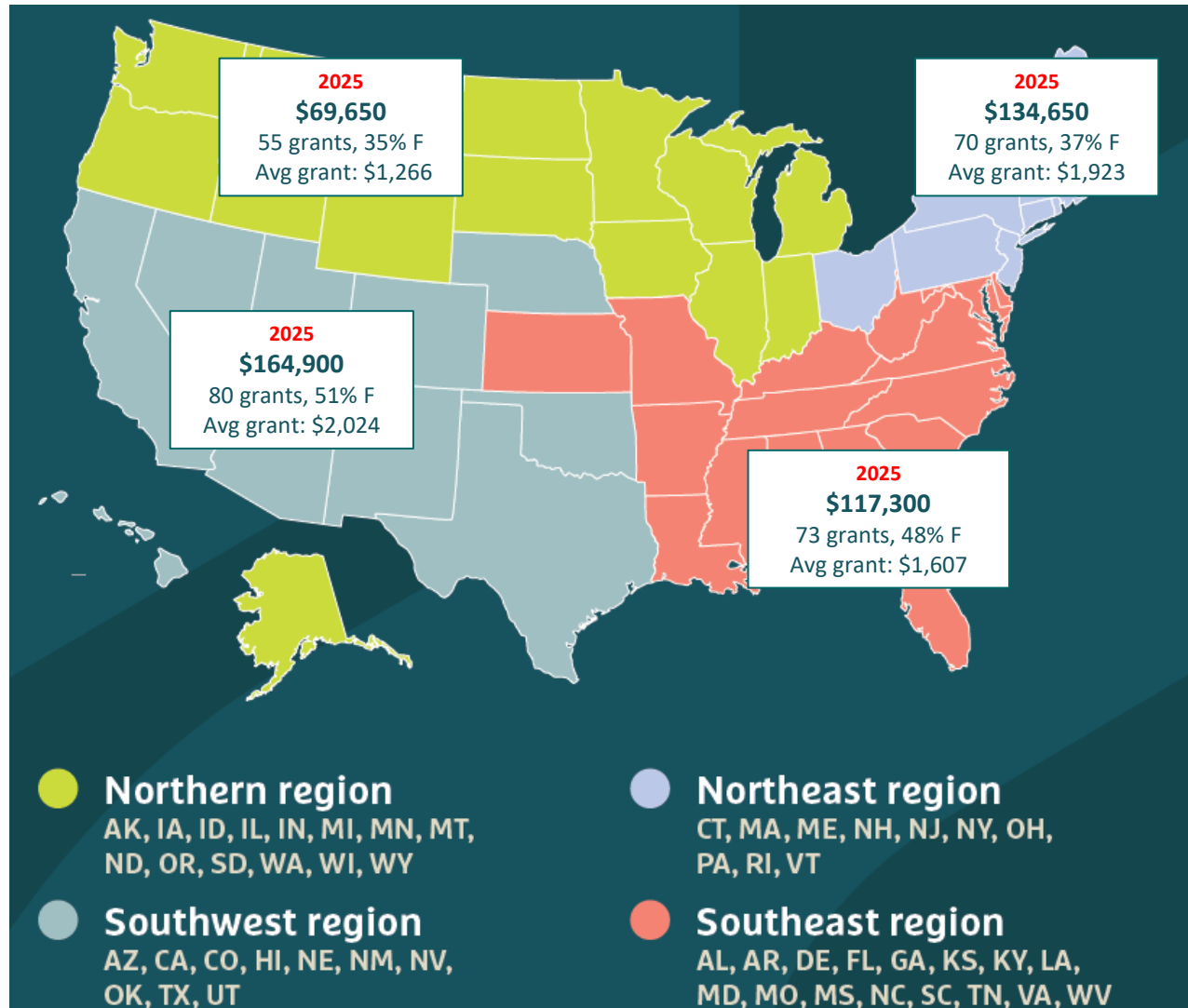

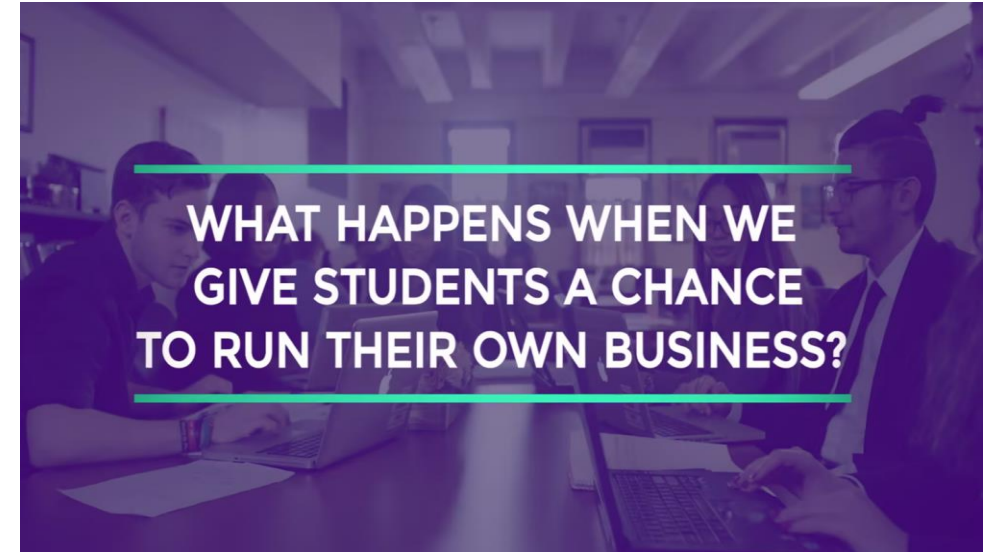
Elevating *Your* Impact: Grant Program
