Why We Like This ETF

The **First Trust Small Cap Growth AlphaDEX® ETF (FYC)** seeks long-term capital appreciation through exposure to small-cap equity securities in the United States. NASDAQ, Inc. administers an “enhanced” index of small-cap stocks selected from the Nasdaq US 700 Small Cap Growth Index that meet certain criteria identified by the AlphaDEX stock selection methodology. From there, the fund identifies and ranks equities based on a variety of technical and fundamental growth factors before selecting the top-ranking growth companies for addition to the portfolio, which is rebalanced quarterly. Critical factors for ranking growth include price momentum, sales-to-price ratio, and one-year sales growth. The result is a true growth portfolio of financially sound companies with proven profitability. The ETF, launched in 2011, has garnered an impressive track record ranking in the top decile versus competitors on trailing 1-, 3-, and 5-year bases, and the top quartile on a trailing 10-year basis. The fund has also generated strong risk-adjusted returns as measured by alpha over the same trailing time periods. Strong performance and consistent philosophy and process have earned the fund a 5-star Morningstar rating.

Where to Use

The **First Trust Small Cap Growth AlphaDEX® ETF** is a strong candidate for investors looking to diversify overvalued, domestic large-cap equity exposure while maintaining a growth focus in the portfolio. Smaller companies largely financed with floating-rate debt stand to benefit significantly as the Federal Reserve continues to cut interest rates. A degree of volatility should be expected from exposure to the small-cap growth asset class, but strong returns, and particularly high risk-adjusted returns, make the strategy worth the volatility.
